Joe Fig

Joe Fig is an artist known for works that explore the creative process and the spaces where art is made. In this new series of drawings Fig is looking for those quiet moments in the studio: moments of contemplation or moments when the artist is absorbed in their work. These drawings are based on his studio visits with the artists included in his recent book Inside the Artists Studio.

Bio

Born in 1968, Fig received both his BFA and MFA from the School of Visual Arts. His body of work encompasses painting, sculpture, photography and drawing, in which he examines the role of the artist, the creative process, and the self-made universe of the artist's studio. Fig's work has been exhibited internationally at the Bruce Museum (Greenwich, CT), Bass Museum of Art (Miami Beach, FL), Parrish Art Museum (Southampton, NY), Toledo Museum of Art (Toledo, OH), Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts (Philadelphia, PA) and New Britain Museum of American Art (New Britain, CT). He is the author of two critically acclaimed books *Inside the Artist's Studio (2015) and Inside the Painter's Studio (2009)* which include his interviews and documentary photographs of todays leading contemporary artists. Fig is represented by Cristin Tierney Gallery in New York. Fig works and lives in Connecticut's Farmington River Valley.
